



PARENTS' GUIDE TO RESTORING THE CULTURE

During the first half term we will be re-enforcing some key behaviours in school. Please help us by ensuring pupils are fully aware of the following expectations.

RESPECT

"Good manners open the closed doors. Bad manners close the open doors."

Checklist of terms to use:

"Please". "Thank you". "Excuse me". Open doors for others. Wait your turn. Speak quietly.

Entry – line up outside the classroom until your teacher invites you in. Once inside the room, stand behind your chair and wait to be seated.

Exit – teacher will invite pupils to stand behind their chair and will then ask them to leave in an orderly fashion

LESSON EXIT AND ENTRY

CORRIDOR CONDUCT

Everyone should walk slowly and quietly.
Do not shout on the corridors.
Maintain a tidy environment.
Unruly behaviour will not be tolerated.
Never loiter on the corridor.
Do not eat or drink

PUNCTUALITY

UNIFORM

Full school uniform is expected to be worn at all times. There are no deviations from the specifics in the student planners.

ORGANISATION

COMPLETING HOMEWORK

- All pupils should complete at least 30 mins to 1 hr of homework a night.
- Pupils should have a routine in place at home so that work can be completed properly.
- Homework should be completed in a quiet area.
