

## COVID-19 HOME TESTING KITS – GENERAL INFORMATION

### **Taking the Test:**

**Pupils will be provided with a leaflet on how to do the test with the kit** – please do not use the instruction leaflet within the box. There is also a useful video to show you how to take the test [here](#).

[Help and support is available](#) including instructions in different languages on how to test and report the results and a video showing you how to take the test.

### **What should you do if there is a positive result?**

If anyone tests **positive** you, your household, any support bubbles you are part of should self-isolate immediately in line with NHS Test and Trace guidance for 10 days.

You should [arrange a confirmatory PCR test](#) at your nearest testing centre, for example Haydock Park.

### **What should you do if there is a void result?**

If the result of the test is **unclear (void)** you should do another test.

### **Reporting a negative and void result**

Negative and void results should be reported to both:-

Remember that a negative result does not guarantee that you are not carrying the virus. So, you should continue to follow social distancing, and other measures to reduce transmission such as wearing a face mask and regularly washing your hands and observing social distancing.

### **Please remember that you need to report each test result**

If you or anyone in your household gets symptoms of the virus you should follow [national guidelines on self-isolation and testing](#).

### **What do I do with the used test equipment?**

There is no need to keep used test equipment after the test result has been reported. You can put it in your normal bin (household waste).

### **Why take part?**

Taking part in testing is voluntary and all students will be able to attend school whether they take part in testing or not.
