School Uniform

We have made some minor tweaks to our uniform code; below shoulder length hair must be tied up in practical subjects <u>only</u> and the minimum length of hair must be no less than a <u>number 2</u> blade (<u>skin fades</u> <u>are not allowed</u>). Tights under skirts are <u>optional</u>. In light of The Childrens' Wellbeing and Schools Bill currently going through parliament we should be in a position to consult with you about our school uniform in September/October, considering the recommendations that come from this Bill.

Could I ask that parents/carers please ensure that pupils **conform to our school uniform rules when the children return to school in September**. Unfortunately, a small number of pupils return to school with inappropriate haircuts/ false nails/piercings, etc and it is a really poor way to start the year for the children as they receive sanctions straight away. These issues are very easily avoided, please support us by ensuring your child conforms to our uniform rules on their return.

School Street

Many thanks to the vast majority of parents who are supporting our procedures for school street, there is no doubt it is making Rookery Avenue a safer environment for our pupils to come into school. Could I just remind the very small number of parents continuing to drop your child off on Vicarage Road, *please don't* as this creates a dangerous situation, both for you as the driver and for the child you are dropping off.
