Dear Parent/Carer

Another year has flown by and it's time once again for my traditional end of year letter.

I hope that your son or daughter has experienced a successful school year; enjoyed friendships, made good progress and seized the many opportunities for personal growth that St Edmund Arrowsmith Catholic High School offers.

As we approach the end of term, I would just like to highlight a couple of important pieces of information.

Parents' Evening Survey

Following my letter dated 24 May 2023 when I asked for your opinion about Parents' Evenings via a survey request. There were 244 responses and the following table shows the results:-

Many thanks for taking the time to respond. With over half the respondents in favour of a move back to face-to-face Parents' Evenings, we will be doing this with all Parents' Evenings next year.

Building Work

Parents may well have noticed that there is building work going on in school. The majority of this work is to repair the roof. However, we have secured some additional funding to improve our reception area, create a new set of pupil toilets and a central 'Pastoral Hub'. We hope that all of these works will be completed by the time we return to school in September.

School Synergy

From September we will be using a new MIS (Management Information System) in school. As such, all of the data held in our current MIS (School Synergy), will transfer to our new MIS (**Arbor**) over the summer holiday. I know that many parents use School Synergy on a daily basis to monitor achievement and behavior points, to check homework and to make contact with school and I am pleased to advise that this functionality will continue with **Arbor**. Over the summer holiday, you will receive a message from School Synergy which will provide you with all the necessary information to allow you to use **Arbor**.

Staff Changes

After 36 years' fantastic service to the school Mrs Payne (some of you will remember her as Miss Shepherd) is retiring from her role as Assistant Headteacher. During her tenure, Mrs Payne has held the roles of Teacher of English, 2nd in English, Head of English and Head of Year. She has had a significant impact in the lives of thousands of pupils over the years and we are blessed that she has dedicated her working life to our school. I am certain that you will join everyone at the school in wishing Mrs Payne a long and happy retirement. We will miss her.

I am delighted to announce that Mr Cullen and Mrs Doolan will be Assistant Headteachers from 1 September 2023. Mrs Hooton will take charge of the RE department next year and Mrs Chadwick will take charge of Year 10.

Further staff leaving us at the end of this year are; Mr Valentine (Maths), Mr Carter (Science), Mr Collinson (Science) and Miss Wood (Geography and Technology). We thank them all for their service to the school and wish them every success in their future careers.
