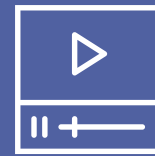

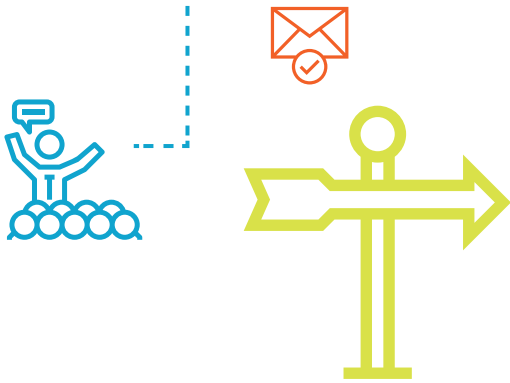

## What will I study?

Our Entry Level Programme introduces learners to the world of work and develops essential skills including personal, social and employability skills in preparation for independent adult life. The course is a two year, four day a week programme which on completion leads to a formal Entry Level qualification.

### Study Programme:

- Preparation for Work, Daily Living Skills, Community, Travel Training, Personal and Social Development, Wellbeing
- Maths and English embedded throughout the whole curriculum

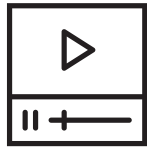

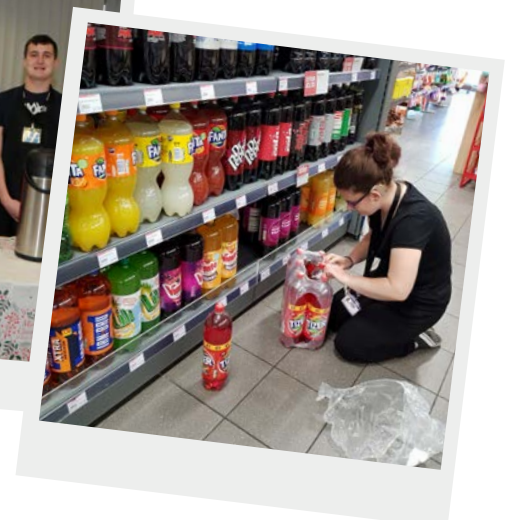
## How do I apply?

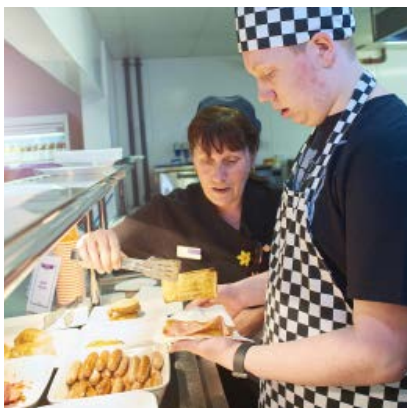
