Internet Access Survey - Year 7

I am writing to you, during these uncertain times, with reference to the ongoing global pandemic and how we as a school can best mitigate this from having a negative effect on your child's education.

It has been wonderful to welcome your child into our school and we sincerely hope to continue to provide our current level of education for as long as possible. However, due to the number of uncertainties at this time, coupled with the current threat of a potential 'second wave', we believe it important to plan for all eventualities.

To help us make sure we can deliver the right support for you and your child should they be required to work remotely from home, we are conducting a survey with our Year 7 parents to gain a greater understanding of the level of internet access in individual households.
