KS2
TRANSITION

Most pupils have prior knowledge of basic Spanish or French acquired through either formal curriculum time at primary school or extra-curricular opportunities (such as language clubs)

Pupils arrive in Year 7 with a varied experience of language learning and inter-cultural understanding.

The year 7 curriculum gives all pupils an opportunity to use their primary language learning as a springboard into languages at high school. In Term 1, pupils follow our bespoke transition module and continue to build transferable language skills in both French and Spanish. Pupils then choose to continue their study of either French or Spanish until the end of Year 9.

Pupils will have developed a good understanding of, and the ability to communicate effectively in the language they have studied.

They will have a strong foundation for further study and for the practical use of a foreign language when visiting other countries.
