

PUPIL PREMIUM ALLOCATION FOR BUDGET 2019/2020

The school estimates to receive **£144,760** during 2019-20 in respect of Pupil Premium Grant. This is based on 136 pupils, 5 service children and 7 Post LAC. If additional funding is received following publication of official figures will be adjusted accordingly.

It is intended to deploy the Pupil Premium to the following areas within the budget to raise achievement and narrow the gap between children from disadvantaged families and their peers.

The number of pupils equates to 12.5% of NOR, therefore we have amended some staffing costs to reflect this rather than the full cost of employing these staff.
