We would like to inform you about our annual school **Remembrance Service**, which will take place on **Tuesday 11 November 2025 at 11:00am**. This important occasion allows our school community to come together in reflection and gratitude for those who have served and sacrificed in times of war and conflict.

All students will participate in the service by observing the two minutes' silence and engaging in a moment of reflection within their classrooms. In addition, two form representatives from each form will take part in a special ceremony at the front of school, where they will lay their form's wreath at the foot of the cross as a mark of respect.

We would also like to extend a special invitation to any students who are members of the cadet services or other organisations that contributed to or were formed as part of the war effort—such as the Guides, Scouts, St John Ambulance, and similar groups. These students are welcome to bring their cadet uniforms into school and change into them once on site.

## Please note:

- All students must arrive at school in full school uniform.
- Cadet uniforms may only be worn after arrival and must be changed back into school uniform at the end of the day.

We are proud to honour this tradition and to support our students in understanding the significance of Remembrance. Thank you for your continued support in helping us mark this solemn and meaningful event.
