## WHAT HAS THIS LAST YEAR MEANT FOR YOU

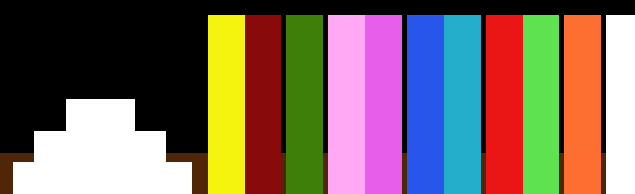


Lord, as this school year comes to an end, we thank you for the opportunities you have presented us with. Opportunities to learn, grow and become young people pleasing to you.

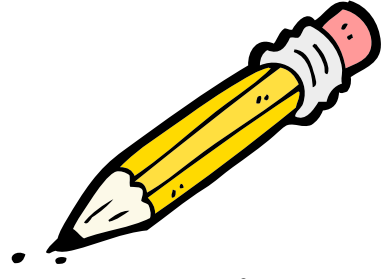

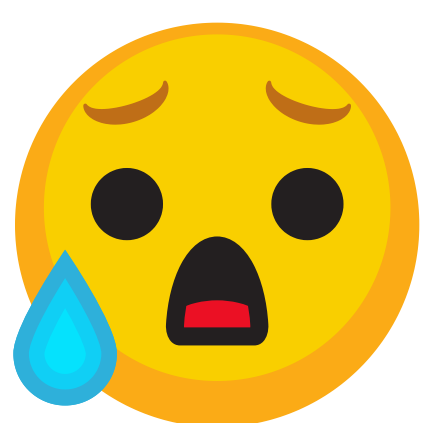


## Looking Back...

8. What have you found challenging?

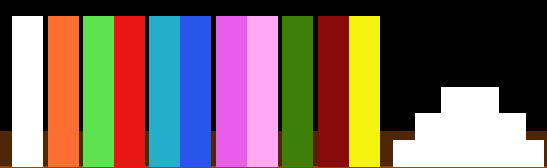
## WHICH FACE REPRESENTS YOUR SCHOOL YEAR?



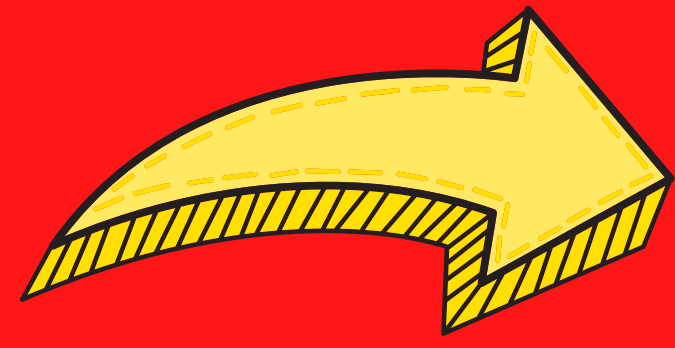
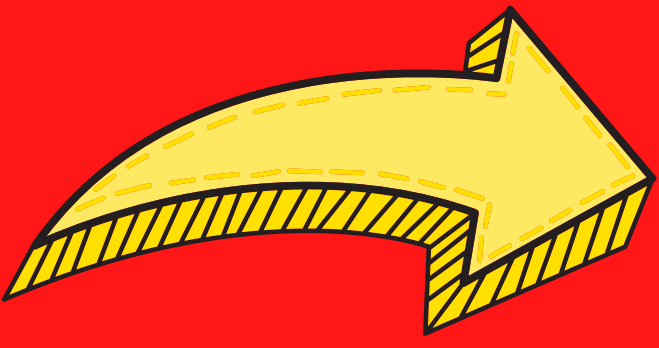
Reflecting on our past allows us to recognise where we went wrong and consider how we could do things differently in the future.

During the summer holidays, spend some time in prayer deciding how your next school year is going to look.

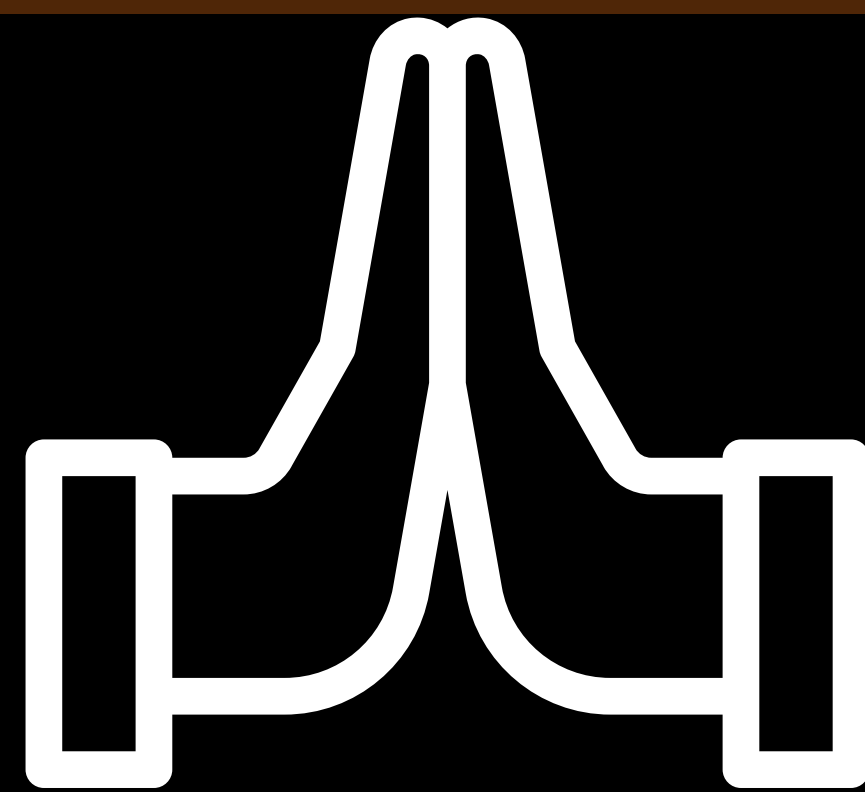
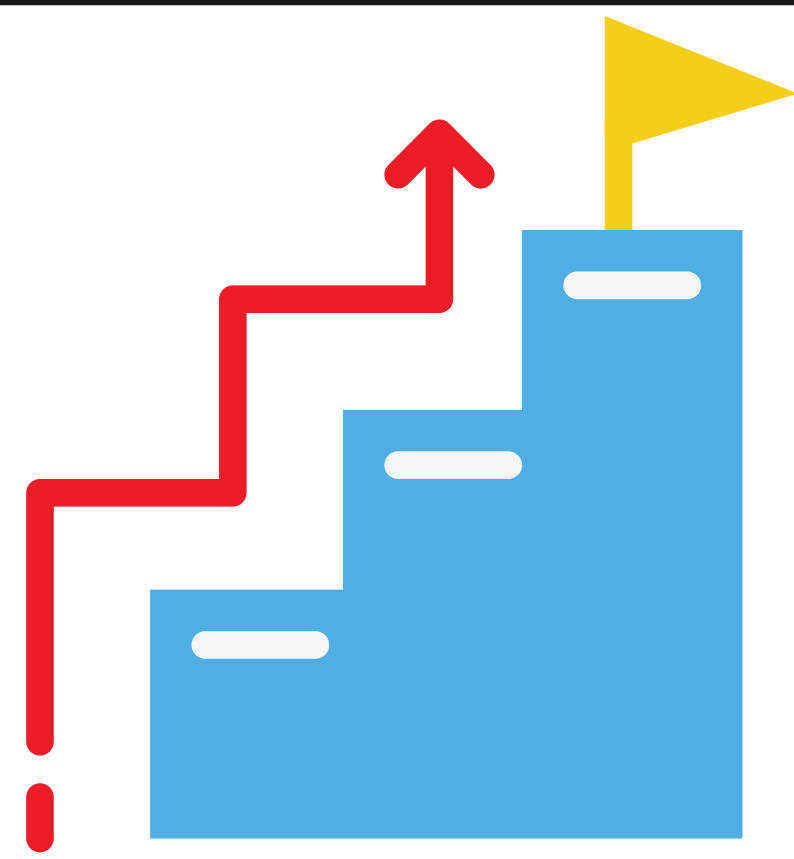


# LOOKING AHEAD!
