# Discover — Autumn 1

## The 'Discover' topic is about ...

The children be discovering the Early Islamic Civilisations this term. The children will explore the some key facts about Baghdad and identify some similarities and differences between life in Baghdad and London in AD 900. The children will also discover why Baghdad was such an important city in the Islamic Empire and how the 'House of Wisdom' played an important part in this. We will also explore what a caliphate is and explain how the first caliphate was formed, leading to the early Islamic civilisation becoming a great power.

#### What we already know...

How to place some historical periods in a chronological framework. They are also able to use historical terms related to the period of study. Included within this, the children can use a range of sources of information, which go beyond simple observations, to answer questions about the past. The children can also communicate learning in an organised and structure what, using appropriate terminology.

#### By the end of the topic

The children will know why the Early Islamic Civilisation is very important within History. They will discover some of the significant discoveries and studies which were led by early Islamic scholars and how the works of early Islamic doctors has influenced modern medicine. They will also know who was Ibn Battuta and how far he travelled. Including, what a caliphate is and explain how the first caliphate was formed, leading to the early Islamic civilisation becoming a great power.

#### By the end of the topic we be able to...

Use dates and a wide range of historical terms when sequencing events and periods of time. Develop chronologically secure knowledge of the events and periods of time studied.
