Discover—Autumn 1

The 'Discover' topic is about ...

Home Sweet Home

What we already know...

Our name

Who our close family is

Some family names e.g. mum. dad

To welcome someone by saying "Hello"

By the end of the topic we will be able to

Recognise (Nursery)/ write some letters from my name (Reception)

Talk about family using vocabulary learnt e.g. brother, sister, aunt, uncle,

Identify photos / talk about themselves from a baby to now

Name friends and teachers in class

Recognise that each family is different

Understand that homes look different for each family- including different countries

Talk about what happens during a Baptism

Talk about different ways to make someone feel welcome

Let's try this at home

Talk about your extended family and who they are to you. When out walking, observe the different types of homes you see and talk about the similarities and differences. Share stories of when you were growing up and your own friends and family. Show your children old photographs and talk about your routines and customs. Encourage your children to talk about their time in school.

Each week we will be sending home a Home Learning Sheet for phonics with all we have learnt that week. Encourage your children to do this with you and practice their sounds and letter formation.
