What we already know...

Stories have characters and settings. Stories have a beginning and an ending.

By the end of the topic we will be able to (EYFS DM)

Reading: 30-50

Suggest how the story might end.

Listen to stories with increasing attention and recall.

Describe main story settings, events and principal characters.

Reading: 40-40

Use vocabulary and forms of speech that are increasingly influenced by our experiences of books.

Enjoy an increasing range of books.

Writing: 40-60

Write for different purposes including labels and captions.

Attempt to write short sentences in meaningful contexts.

Understanding: 40-60

Able to follow a story without pictures or props.

Speaking: 40-60

Extend our vocabulary, especially by grouping and naming, exploring the meaning and sounds of new words. (see vocabulary)

Let's try this at home

Read/share your reading book every day.

Practise writing words and short sentences containing the letters we have practised in our phonic lessons linked to the stories we have experienced.

Listen to lots of traditional tales either from books or online: **Youtube: Oxbridge Baby traditional tales. Youtube: Debbie and friends Traditional tales as songs.**

Act out some of the stories together and talk about the sequence and vocabulary.
