Create — Summer 2 Cycle B

The 'Create' topic is about ...learning through creation. The children will design a healthy fruit kebab based on food combinations which work well together.

In English the children will be able to write a story with a seaside setting and write a seaside poem.

In RE the children will discuss why Christians believe that life is God's gift and also learn about the Hindu God's, places of worship and main values.

In science we will find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.

What we already know...the children know that fruit is a healthy option and can help us stay fit and well. They know that plants need water and light to grow.

By the end of the topic we will know (NC)

- How to chop fruit and vegetables safely.
- How to develop a food vocabulary using taste, smell, texture and feel.
- How to include: subordination for time and reason. The suffix *-ly* to turn adjectives into adverbs in their writing.
- How to observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants.

By the end of the topic we will be able to (skills progression)

- Children will be able to evaluate their writing with adults and peers.
- Will be able to write an explanation text.
- Understand the need for a variety of foods in a diet.
