Year 1&2 Knowledge Organiser

Create — Summer 2 Cycle A

The 'Create' topic is about ... learning through creation. The children will further develop their creative skills by drawing shapes from observations and by investigating textures by describing, naming, rubbing and copying.

In science they will identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees.

In English the children will be creating their own stories with fantasy settings and using basic drama techniques to explore character choices and feelings.

In RE they will be able to explain that loving our neighbours is an important part of Christian living and they will also learn about Hinduism's main values and the different aspects of Hinduism and Hindu festivals.

What we already know... they know how to use some different drawing materials. They know the names of some plants and trees and they know what foods are healthy and unhealthy to eat.

By the end of the topic we will know (NC)

- How to make rubbings to collect textures and patterns.
- How to identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees.
- How to group familiar food products e.g. fruit and vegetables.
- How to discuss some of the risks that are present when we go online

By the end of the topic we will be able to (skills progression)

- Draw on different surfaces with a range of media.
- To be able to take turns and listen to what others say.
- Cut, peel, grate, chop a range of ingredients.
- Work safely and hygienically.
