Dear Parents/Carers and Children

However as numbers in other year groups grow the pressure and demand for places increases. Therefore after next week we have to limit the number of key worker children so places will be restricted. I do hope over the last two weeks you have been able to take a break from learning and concentrate on quality family time.
