Dear Parents/Carers

It has been a joy this week to welcome back all the children to school, it is so important to continue in as normal way as possible. Overall we are managing to deliver a full curriculum, lots of clubs and activities and the children are continuing with all aspects of school life very well.

However, just this week we have seen a high number of cases throughout school and we must continue to be vigilant. Currently staffing levels are good but the way the variant is spreading it is only a matter of time before more staff are impacted.

Therefore I urge you to assist us with the following procedures:

- Please Lateral Flow Test your children regularly
- If there is a positive case in the class and we send a warning letter please LFT your children every day for 7 days
- Please keep your children at home if they display any of the main associated symptoms; temperature, cough, runny nose, headache, fatigue, sneezing, sore throat
- Please remember to wear masks when dropping off, collecting or visiting the office
- Only one parent/carer attends site to drop off or collect

Whilst we continue not to have class mass and assemblies for parents, the majority of other events and activities are taking place and the list is constantly updated.
