### Asthma Cards

As part of accepted good practice and with advice from the Department for Education and Asthma UK, our school will be continuing a School Asthma Policy for use by all staff and will use the 'Asthma Card' which parents/carers are required to complete. If your child has asthma please collect a card from your class teacher or the school office. If you have completed a card previously and the circumstances have not changed there is no need to complete a new one.

Children who have 'reliever' inhalers in school are permitted to keep them on their person, in their tray, bag or locker. It is expected that they are aware of the signs of needing an inhaler and can administer it themselves. Obviously younger children will be given support if required.

### Easy Fundraising

We are now registered for easy fundraising; here are some more details. Type in [www.easyfundraising.org.uk](http://www.easyfundraising.org.uk) and go to **Search for cause** and type **St Hugh of Lincoln RC Primary School**. Click **Join us** and create your own account by filling in your details (name, address, email etc). Once completed click on **create my account**. Once your account is created you can shop with various retailers (over 3,000), such as **Amazon, Ebay, Asda, Marks&Spencers, Tesco, Debenhams, Wilkinson, Wickes, Waitrose, Ocado, B&Q, Groupon, John Lewis, Next etc**. If you are renewing your car insurance, house insurance or booking a holiday there are many companies you can go through to do this and they usually give a larger percentage of a donation.

So next time you shop online please login to your easyfundraising account, type in the retailer (eg. Amazon) in the search box, when their name comes up click on go shopping and it will direct you to the retailer, shop for your purchases and you should be able to check your account to see how much you are raising. All retailers have different percentages they will donate to the school and it costs you nothing.
