Dear Parents/Carers

Hope you are all well, there has been a number of cases of children with Covid in school and in addition to this there has been a sickness bug. Please refer to the Trafford Covid guidance in our previous letter and we remind you if your child has been sick, they must not come in to school until they have been free of symptoms for 48 hours.

Holiday Absence

Since our return to school we have had a number of families taking holidays during term time. Whilst we understand these are sometimes unavoidable, we need to remind you the importance of your child/ren attending school and not missing vital parts of the curriculum. As a school in the past we have never followed the government guidelines of fining parents who take their children out of school during term time, however this may be something the school will need to look into if these absences continue.

PTA – Halloween Disco

Thank you to the parents who attended our first PTA meeting of the year. Following on from that meeting it was decided that the school would be holding two separate Halloween Disco's for children in EYFS/Key Stage 1 and children in Key Stage 2 on Friday 21st October.

Any parents that wish to donate unwanted Halloween costumes can leave in the Reception Area. We will organise a date/time before the disco for anyone wishing to take one for their child.
