Dear Parents/Carers

It is absolutely wonderful to welcome everyone back to school and it has been a real joy visiting the classrooms and seeing all the smiling faces. Today we celebrated our first school mass of the year with Father Ged.

Children can arrive anytime from 8.45am and go into class ready for the start of the day at 8.55am. The only difference is that children in Nursery and Reception use the main car park entrance. Children in Year 1-6 can make their own way into class.

A reminder that the car park will be closed from 8.30 as the entrance will be used; please park considerately.

This term school will gradually open up and over the course of the next few weeks clubs will start once more and more events will be added. On Friday teachers will be sending out welcome letters which will outline class procedures such as information about reading books and will also give you information about your child's curriculum coverage this year. Additional resources will be sent out via Google Classroom over the course of the year to support work carried out in class. In the next few weeks homework will be added to Google Classroom (the welcome letter from your child's class teacher will outline this). However please be patient, as with any online system at the start of the year, class registers will need to be updated. In the meantime please do not hesitate should you have any questions; we are always available.

For children in Reception to Year 2, hot school dinners are free and for everyone else the cost this term will be £79.20 or £12 per week if you prefer. All payments are made electronically through ParentPay.

The children all looked fantastic in their school uniform and throughout the course of the school year we expect this high standard to be maintained. Can we remind everyone of our school uniform policy of shirt and tie during the Autumn/Winter months and polo shirts/summer dresses in Spring/Summer.

We would also like to remind you that due to health and safety, pets are not permitted on the school premises. We have to always be mindful of the safety of our children and we know we can rely on your support for this.

We would just like to add a thank you for your support in our new role as Acting Headteachers and look forward to speaking to you throughout the year.
