As you know, COVID willing, we always have a residential trip with our Year 6 children. The trip is a great way to end your child's time at school and is always very enjoyable and remembered for many years to come.

The trip will be from Tuesday 17th May until Friday 20th May 2022. It is for three nights at the Youth Hostel in Grasmere, a stunningly beautiful village in the Lake District (the home of William Wordsworth). While there we undertake lots of activities including canoeing, gorge scrambling and walking etc.

The cost of the trip which includes 3 nights full board accommodation, travel costs including fuel and all activities is £220.
