<p><u>Games and Extensions</u></p>	<p><u>Crumpled paper throw</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Write long and short 'oo' sound words on paper.• One word on one bit of paper.• Crumple the paper up.• Write as many as you can think of for each 'oo' sound.• Put all the crumpled-up words in a pile.• Child picks a crumpled bit of paper, opens it and reads it, if it is a long 'oo' sound like moon, crumple it back up and throw it UP to the MOON.

- If it is a short 'oo' sound like foot, crumple it back up and throw it down to your FOOT!
- How fast can you go?
- Time yourself.
