Dear Parents

This week we are excited to be able to talk to you face to face at our year group evenings where you will find out all about the expectations for your child as they move into their new year group and will be able to ask any questions to the staff present. If you take the time to visit your child's new year group web page with them, they will be able to find out more about their new teachers and the learning that will take place. There is also the class email there too. Your teachers will point this out to you at the virtual meetings

The week beginning 27th June is an important week with regard to transition for your child to their next year group.
