Homework in Year 4

Children will need to bring their reading book and reading record into school every day. The expectation is that all children read at home at least 3 times a week and that an adult writes the comment / signs the reading record. For now, children will change their book once a week, on Tuesdays. They can pick two books if one will not last the week. This is to help reduce the number of children in the library at any one time due to restrictions.

Spellings will be set on Friday and tested the following Thursday or Friday. Weekly homework will follow the same format as Year 3. Children can pick an activity to complete and bring it in on for the following Thursday.
