#### Our Breakfast Club

St Joseph's have now been running a successful Breakfast Club since September 2020.

We started with only a handful of children and now we have over 25 children attending. At St Joseph's Breakfast Club we have a relaxed and calm atmosphere where children are seated and enjoy a variety of breakfast items.

Alongside our usual cereal and toast, we have a variety of fruit, orange, apple and pineapple juice with chocolate milk shake and hot chocolate on the menu occasionally.

Our Cooked Breakfast Friday is very popular with all the children where we offer sausage baps, or sausage beans and hash browns.

After breakfast children continue to sit and enjoy a calm relaxed activity and sometimes a story time for little ones.

We pride ourselves on our Breakfast Club and look forward to seeing more children throughout the year.

Breakfast Club costs £2.50 per child and can be paid online in advance or daily drop in paying cash on the day.

### **NOTICE**

Parents with children with special requirements i.e. vegetarian, cultural, religious or dietary - Please contact the kitchen with any information that will help with a hot meal.

Key stage 2 meals are priced at £2.50 per meal per day, £12.50 per week. Term payment Mon 28<sup>th</sup> Feb – Fri 8<sup>th</sup> April = 30 days £75.00 Payments can be paid weekly, fortnightly, monthly or even termly.



Some of our menu items contain allergens, including: Cereals containing gluten, milk, eggs, etc.

Peanuts and nuts are also classed as allergens, but these are not used on our menu as we have pupils who have certain allergies.

If your child has an allergy i.e.,
wheat, soya, lactose, gluten, we will
need written confirmation of the
special dietary needs for your child.

Our dedicated and qualified catering team are able to provide details of food allergens on request.

### Reception, Y1 & Y2 UIFSM

All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are automatically entitled to a free school meal.

This does not mean that your child has to have a meal. However as a school we would strongly encourage it as children will receive a hot meal that is nutritionally balanced. It is also important part of the school day as they practise their table manners and improve their social skills. Also saving you an average of £437.00 a year.

## Points on Ordering

### **KEY STAGE 2 ONLY**

All lunch payments are required to be paid in advance online via payments for schools by Thursday midnight.

No payments will be accepted after given date.

Payment for lunches at the end of a term need to be paid by Thursday prior to end of a term. For example payment this Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> Feb will be for lunches week commencing Monday 28<sup>th</sup> Feb.

Please do not pay for lunches in school holidays as no payments are calculated in school holidays.

If you need to cancel your child's lunch due to sickness, absence or school trip please ring school kitchen on 01905 340325 by 9.30am on day of absence

NOTE: If you do not cancel your child's lunch then unfortunately you will not be eligible to claim a credit for this day.
