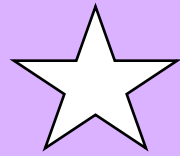


Today's task

You're going to be writing a character description on The Rabbit in our story. You need to use your plan to support you.

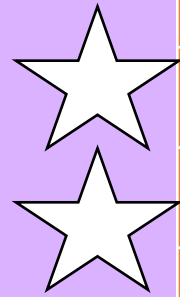
