How to make playdough

What you will need

- 1. 8 tbsp plain flour
- 2. 2 tbsp table salt
- 3. 60ml warm water
- 4. Food colouring
- 5. I tbsp veqetable oil





Method

I. Mix the flour and salt in a large bowl. In another bowl mix the water and a few drops of food colouring and the oil.

2. Pour the coloured water into the flour mix and bring together with a spoon.

3. Dust a work surface with a little flour and turn out the dough. Knead together for a few minutes to form a smooth dough.

4. Store in a plastic sandwich bag (squeeze out the air) in the fridge to keep it fresh.
