Following the success of the asymptomatic testing programme on the return to school, our staff will continue to keep testing at home throughout the Easter holidays and into the summer term. Testing was discussed on the last parent Zoom. For your information, families and households can also access information by using this link home test kits for adults.

Dear Parents,

We are really pleased to be able to inform you that Warndon Safer Neighbourhood Team and St Joseph's Catholic Primary School will be continuing to work closely with each other to address the ongoing issues relating to irresponsible parking outside the school.

The irresponsible nature of parking that occurs is as follows:

Parking on the yellow School Keep Clear Zig Zags.

- Parking on double yellow lines.
- · Parking over junctions.

The Warndon Safer Neighbourhood Team have noticed that with the increase in the amount of vehicles being used to drop off and pick children up from the school as lockdown is eased, so the problems are arising again.

All parking restrictions outside schools are there for the safety of the pupils, pedestrians and staff – not for the drivers' convenience. They are there so that pupils crossing the road can see approaching traffic and to ensure drivers can see them.

Your local Police Officers and Police Community Support Officers will be patrolling the area, especially during school drop off and pick up times. We will also be working closely with the Civil Enforcement Officers to address this issue.

This letter has been sent to you to advise you of the situation that is being witnessed. If you are seen to park illegally outside of the school then a Fixed Penalty Notice could be given and the driver will be fined.

Our aim is to educate motorists who are being inconsiderate, that their behaviour will not be tolerated and that they will be dealt with appropriately before a serious accident occurs.
