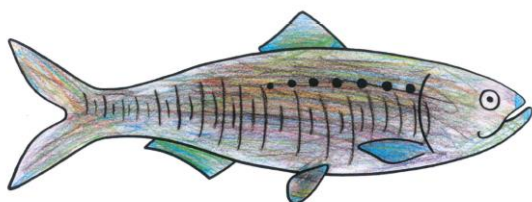

THE SHAD FLAG COMPETITION

SCHOOLCHILDREN from across Worcestershire have designed a flag for fish migration day.

This May, for the first time in nearly 180 years, the UK's longest river has been unlocked for the epic spawning migration of an endangered fish, the twaite shad.

The flag features the winning artwork of local children inspired by the plight of this fish and the conservation project that has worked to restore the river to them.

From over 1000 entries received, five winning shad designs have been selected from local Worcester school children.
