

How To Register

- Download the "School Food United" app from the <u>Apple Store</u> or <u>Google Play</u> or visit <u>https://parents.schoolfoodunited.com/login</u> & select the 'register' button.
- Add your details* and create a password -You will then receive a confirmation email. Click on the link in the email to verify.
- 3. Log in and select 'add child' then type your child's details into the app or the online form and choose from the dropdowns; your child's school, year and class options. Repeat for each child.

Once registered you can start placing orders straight away.
