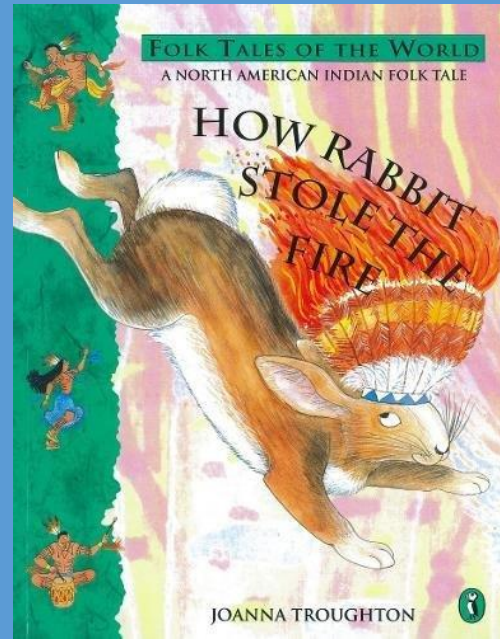


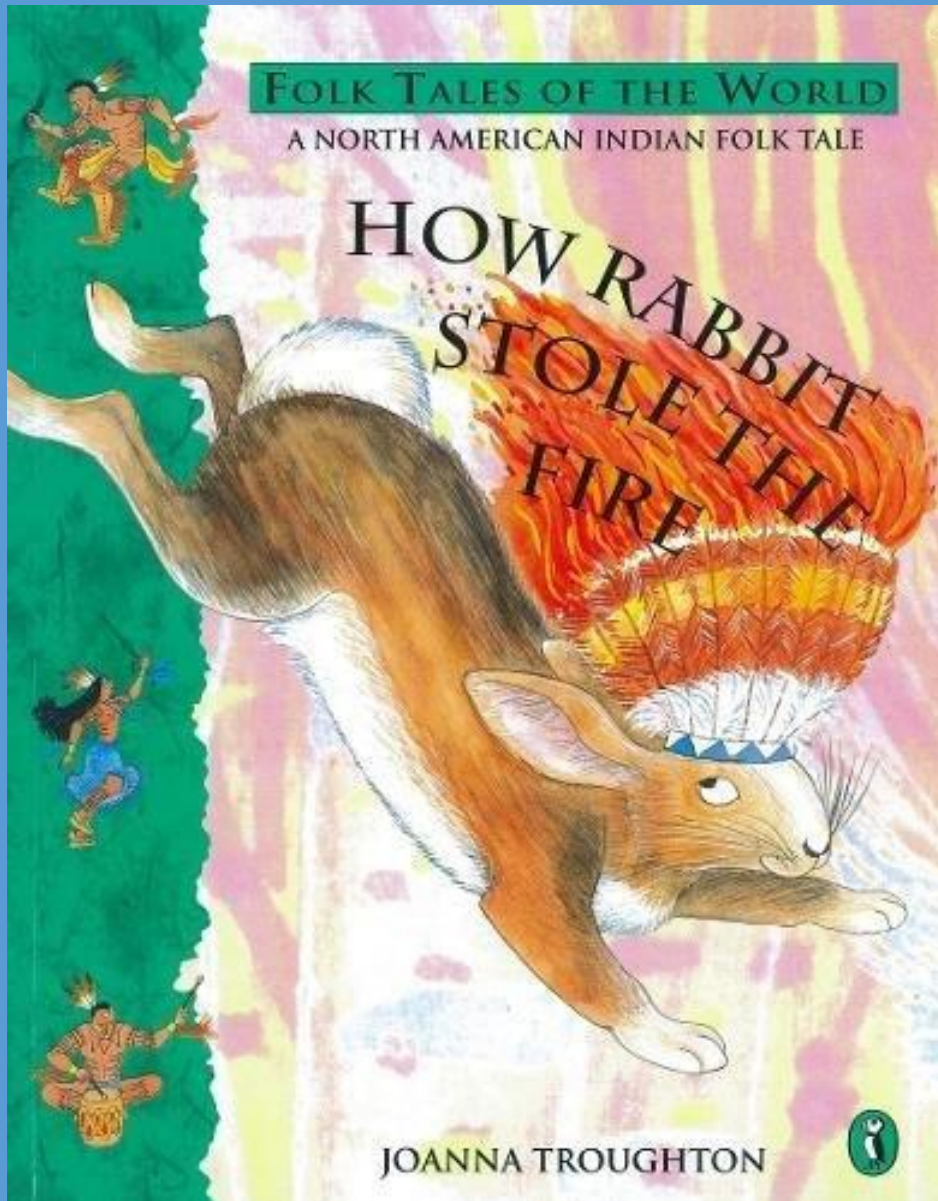

To complete today's task, children can write the number of the question and answer directly onto a piece of paper.

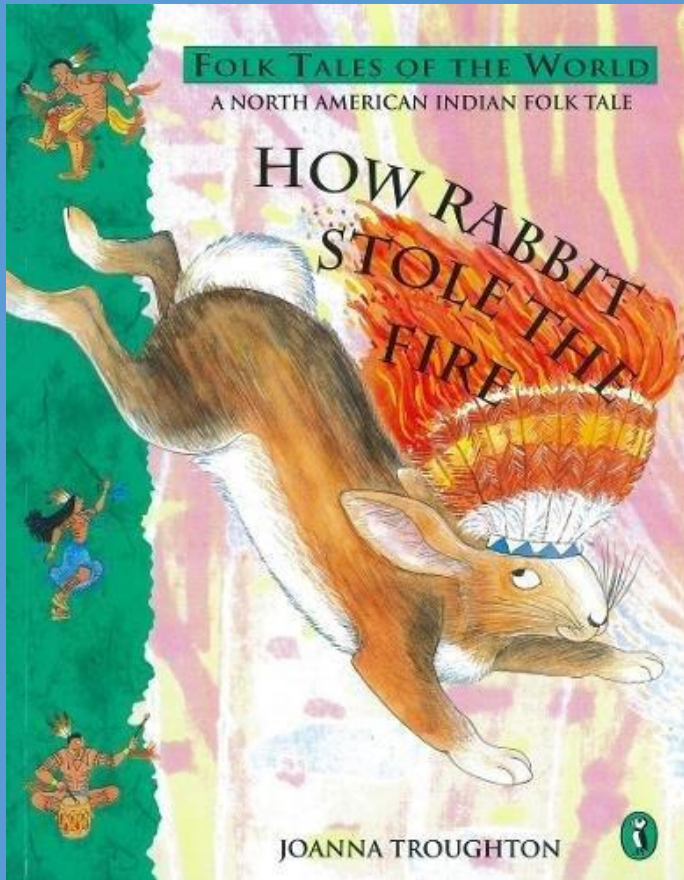

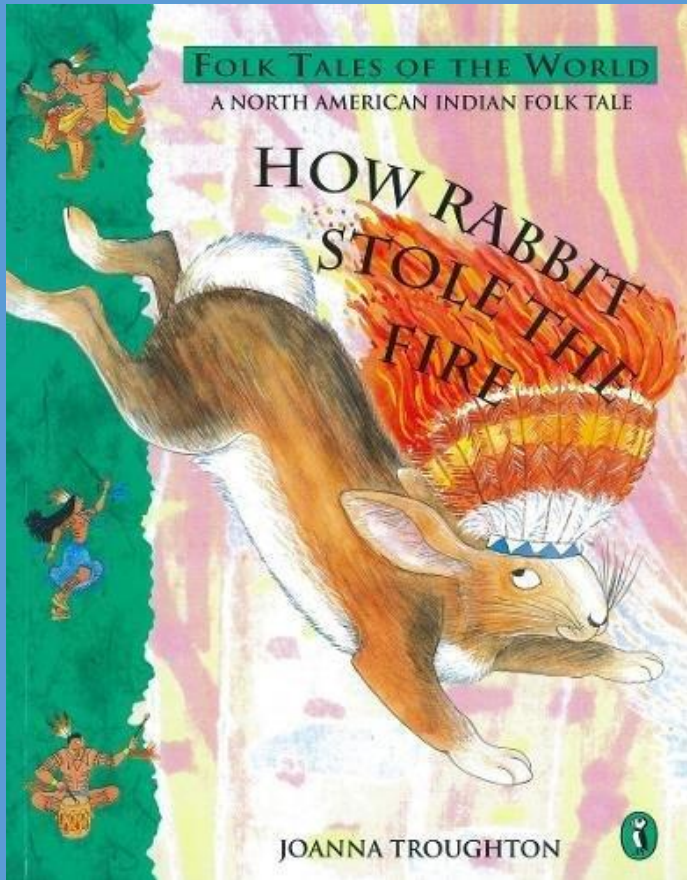

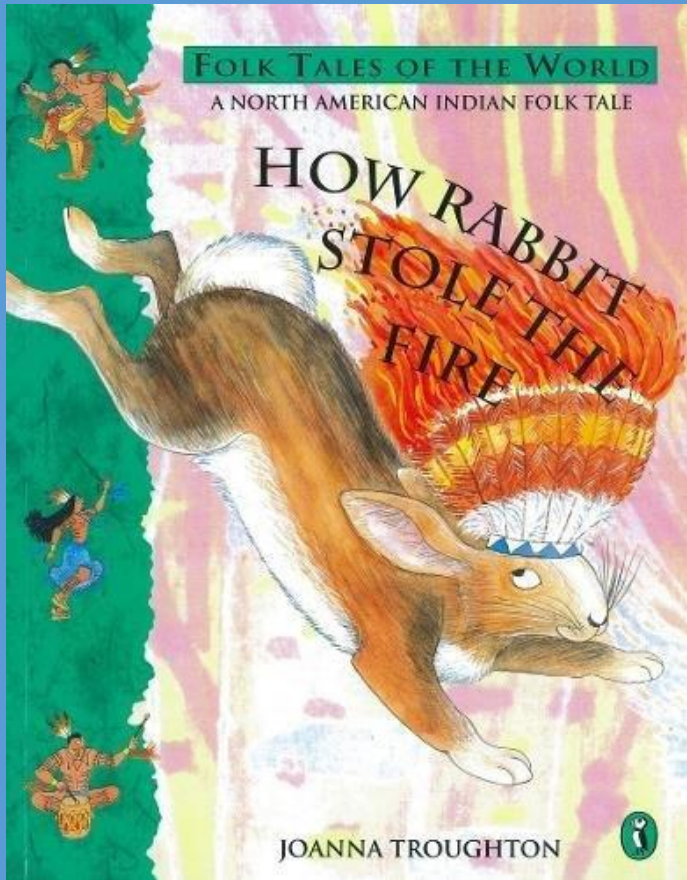
