- 5. Use clear descriptions.







### My Example: How To Make A Head Dress

#### You will need:

- Paper
- Scissors
- A green, orange, red and white pen.
- Sellotape
- 3 Feathers

#### What to do:

- I. First, cut out a strip of paper. You need to measure this carefully as the strip needs to go around the whole of your head.
- 2. Next, you need your green, orange, red and white pens. Delicately, draw a design on the strip of paper.
- 3. After, grab your Sellotape. Use the Sellotape to stick the to ends of the paper together. Be careful, you don't need much! We need to secure this carefully because we do not want our head dress to fall apart.
- 4. Finally, slowly add your three feathers to the front of the head dress. Make sure they are secure.

#### Top Tip:

Make sure you use bright colours so your head dress will stand out!
