Warm Weather

As we enter our final few weeks of this academic year we hope the lovely warm weather continues. In order to help everyone continue to stay safe in the heat we have a few reminders and recommendations.

- Please bring a sun hat to school please make sure it has name on it
- Please apply sun cream children are able to bring sun cream to school to reapply if they can do it themselves, staff are not allowed to apply it for them. They must not share this with other children
- Please use an ice pack inside lunch boxes to help keep food cool
- Please remember a water bottle no squash in water bottles please

Key Stage 2 children currently store their lunch boxes on trolleys outside their classrooms, please be assured that every effort is made to move them if they are in direct sunlight. The storage of lunch trolleys outside enables the classroom space to be less cluttered and dedicated to learning. As the weather heats up an ice pack would help to control the temperature of the lunch box. We are problem solving a long-term solution for this but in the meantime, this might be an ideal time to try the school lunches instead. The kitchen team have worked hard to provide a menu that covers all tastes and is full of children's favourites.
