Please ensure that your child brings a hat to school named and suncream is applied before coming to school.

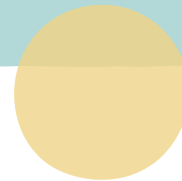
We are applying our risk assessment procedures with regards to time outside in the heat, please be assured that your child will be kept safe and cool during this warm weather.
