

- Tinga Tinga art is an art movement that began in Tanzania and spread to most of east Africa.
- The paintings are bright and colourful and usually show the elephant, rhino, buffalo, lion or leopard.
- They are designed to appeal to European and American tourists.








- Edward Tingatinga began the art movement in 1968 but died 4 years later. His style of work is now copied across Eastern Africa.
- He became one of the most famous artists in Africa.

Tinga Tinga Tales

- A whole series of children's TV programs was based upon the paintings by Edward Tingatinga.
- They told stories of different African animals and used the bright colours and bold patterns that Edward Tingatinga had used in his original artwork.







- Lots of bold bright colours
