HAWSE END INFORMATION

Dear Parent,

We hope your child is starting to feel excited to go to Hawse End next week on Wednesday 3rd July. Miss Mawson, Mrs Austin and myself will be supporting the children on this residential. Ghyll scrambling, canoeing and orienteering are some of the planned activities. I have attached a copy of the kit list to help our pupils pack the correct things. Please can all items of clothing be labelled – this helps reduce the likelihood of lost property, as all items can easily be returned.

Children need to arrive at school at the normal time on Wednesday morning and bring their bags into the Year 6 classroom. We will leave school, by coach, at approximately 9:30am and arrive back at school between 2 and 2:30pm on Friday 5th July. Children may be collected after 2.30pm. We are happy to keep children in school until 3.30pm if necessary. Please let us know if this will be required.

Children will require a packed lunch and drink for Wednesday. They should bring this in a packed lunch box or bag that they can use for the rest of the trip. As usual, please don't send any glass bottles however, a drinks bottle is a good idea so that they can fill it up when they are away. Pupils will not need any money as there is no shop at the centre and nowhere to spend any money.

If your child is on any medication, there is a form which will need to be completed prior to the trip and this, alongside the medication, will need to be given to Miss Rowe on the morning of the trip. This will include the doses and times of when it needs administered. We will then keep the medication and administer it as requested. Any inhalers should remain with your child, who will need to show it to the instructors before each activity. If they require their inhaler before bedtime, or when they wake up, please inform myself so that we can ensure this happens. If there is any concern about a child, rest assured, you will be contacted for advice, so please don't worry.

If you have any concerns regarding bed wetting, menstruation or any other personal information, please come and speak to me privately. In the case of an emergency, please contact school and school staff will contact the centre directly.

Please ensure the children do not bring any electronic items, including mobile phones. **Mobile phones are not permitted on this trip.**

We will be taking many photos whilst we are away and photos will be uploaded to Seesaw during the trip. Please ask if you need a new login code.

I am sure the children will all have a great time.
