Hawse End Information and Kit List

I am sure your child will now be getting quite excited about our residential. Miss Rowe, Miss Mawson and Mrs Austin will be accompanying the children to Hawse End. There will be a staff car available should there be any emergency on site. In preparing for this residential, please try to avoid buying any new items of clothing for this trip – old, practical and comfy clothes are best. It is also really beneficial if the children pack themselves or with your support as they are then aware of what is in their bag. Each child will be provided with a set of fleeces, waterproofs and wellies from Hawse End. Any wet clothes can be hung up in the drying room at the centre overnight. A black bin bag is useful to put any wet or dirty items into on the last day.

Listed below are items which your child will need to pack.

Kit List

- Toothbrush/toothpaste
- Shower gel
- 1 pair of old trainers for wet activities
- 1 pair of trainers for dry activities (preferably with good grips)
- 1 pair of slippers or indoor shoes
- Anorak or coat
- 3 jumpers/sweatshirts
- 3 T-shirts
- 4 changes of underwear
- 2 pairs of thick socks
- 3/4 pairs of ordinary socks
- 2 pairs of trousers/tracksuit bottoms (Not jeans)
- Swimwear
- 2 towels
- Sleepwear
- Hat and gloves
- Large black bin liner (to take wet clothes home)
- Plastic drinks bottle
- Packed lunch (for the Wednesday) in a box or bag which can be used during the trip.

Medication

Any medication must be labelled with your child's name and a form will need to be filled in prior to the visit with details of dosage and administration. These will need to be handed to Miss Rowe on the morning of the trip.
