RESIDENTIAL TRIP TO HAWSE END

Dear Parent / Carer

As you may know, each year we arrange for our Year 6 children to attend a residential trip in order to fulfil the outdoor activities part of the National Curriculum. This gives the children the opportunity to develop their independence, teamwork and confidence which we feel has a great benefit to their lives, both at school and at home.

It is now time to start planning the next year's trip. This time we will be going to Hawes End, near Keswick, between 22 and 24 June – two nights in total.

We will be inviting all Year 6 parents and their children to a short meeting after school on Tuesday 2 November (just after half term). We will use the opportunity to explain the types of activities available at Hawse End and give a brief outline of what the children can expect, what they will need and the benefits of going. It will be short and informal, from about 3.35pm to 4.00pm.

The total cost of the trip, which covers full board accommodation and activities (including safety equipment and certificates) is £170. The school will subsidise the remaining costs including transport to and from the centre as clearly there are major educational and social benefits for the children.

We will be asking for deposits of £50 to be paid by Friday 19 November and for the remaining balances to be paid before the end of May 2022. Those children who are in receipt of Pupil Premium will have their trips paid for through school. We are happy to receive payment in instalments and are setting up an online payment facility via Lunchshop which allows you to pay as and when you choose. This will be live from 1 November. You will need your Lunchshop password, and so if you do not have one, please contact the office and we will reset it for you. If you have any concerns about payment, please speak to Mrs Smith. Places will only be booked for those who have paid the deposit by the deadline (or who have made financial arrangements with the school). We do stress, however, that this is a requirement of the curriculum and we do expect all children to attend.
