<p><u>ENGLISH</u> Reading</p>	<p>Try to read for 20 minutes a day. See the VIPERS document below for some questions you could talk about with an adult, linked to your book. Remember you can access e books from the Oxford Owl website. You can access this resource by clicking on the link below and asking your parent to create a log in. Can you write a book review of your favourite book? Why is it your favourite? Can you try to persuade a friend from school to read it in your review?</p>
<p>Writing</p>	<p>Persuasive Writing – Should we wear school uniform or not?</p> <p>In this unit of work there are 10 lessons, each with a video. You will look in detail about the features of a persuasive letter. It will require you to use emotive language, in order to sound surprised. The style of your writing will also include formal conjunctions, so as to link your ideas together coherently. Persuading your reader that your approach and ideas are the best is no mean feat! Backing up your argument with sound reasons and facts can be quite a challenge. Good luck in writing persuasively!</p>
<p>Spelling</p>	<p>Choose 10 words from either the 3 & 4 or the Year 5 & 6 word list that you find tricky to spell. Can you write these words in rainbow colours? What else can you do to help you remember these spellings? Can you see a pattern in the word or a word within the word? Can you use dots and dashes to break up the word? Try some of the 'Spellwell' activities with the words you have chosen. Example: a=1, b=2, c=3, d=4, etc. Then convert your words to a number code. <i>You must write the actual spelling word next to the "code word."</i></p></div> <p>Try to spend 20 minutes practising your spellings every day.</p>
