

Oro-Motor activities to promote clarity of speech:

- blowing bubbles
- blowing through straws
- Encourage singing – using his voice with music in any way he can.
- encourage dancing, clapping to music as well as singing the tune – at first don't worry about the words, use "lala" or "ahah" or any other sound
- Play games using different voices – a baby's, a man's, a little girl's, a teddy bear's, a mouse's, other animals etc. – this helps teach control of pitch.
- Push lips forward for kissing practice holding a pencil between the child's upper lip and nose.
