

# What do the STLS do in schools/settings:

- ✓ Either *visit* your child just once to offer advice or visit more regularly.
- ✓ Observe your child in class, speak to their teacher, TA, key person or the SENCO and we can also meet with yourselves as parents/carers.
- ✓ Give advice to staff on strategies and resources which may help your child.
- Set targets for pupils and staff to work towards.
- ✓ Make *review* visits if appropriate.
- ✓ Write a *report* of our visit, which will be shared with you as parents/carers.
- ✓ Provide specialist *training* for schools/settings.
- Following *agreement* with the school/setting, cases may be closed if our support is no longer needed, but your child can be referred back to us at any time.
