How to do Intensive Interaction

Watch the child looking for behaviours/communication



- o Respond to the child and follow his lead
- o Sometimes offer touch/noises; but do not insist the child takes them up
- Sometimes copy the child's behaviours and noises
- o Do not force, dominate or direct
- Have <u>fun</u> yourself
- o Be <u>relaxed</u>



- Go at the <u>child's own pace</u>
- o Act and then pause, so that the child has time to respond



- Position yourself at the <u>child's level</u>
- Allow the child to control the duration and focus of the interaction
- o Talk at the child's level of understanding and make what you say relevant
