Headlines:

- 100% made outstanding progress against St. Nicholas criteria. The remaining pupil made good progress.
- 91% achieved the median quartile or above. 82% achieved within the UQ. 55% achieved above UQ 18% achieved UQ++ or UQ+++.
- 63% of the pupils performed at such a level as their progress was only exceeded by 3% of the progression guidance data set; 4 pupils achieved the equivalent progress as the highest standard achieved
- 100% met national expectations (2 levels) / 91% exceeded expectation.
- 91% achieved more than 2 VA levels, 64% achieved at least 4 or above.

7 out of 11 pupils exceeded CASPA expectation, the remainder met CASPA expectation

- · Review need type classes and for example, developing the SHINE curriculum for ambulant pupils in SHINE class

- To develop the training of on body signing for some pupils on the Cedar Pathway.
- Increased use of Lego Therapy across the department, developing the use of expressive language skills and receptive language skills.

- 100% achieved at least MQ. 91% achieved within the UQ. 82% made progress above UQ. 73% of pupils achieved UQ++ or above.
- 3 pupils achieved the equivalent to the top 8% of the progression guidance data set; these children were only bettered by 2%
- 91% achieved at least 3 VA levels, 55% 4 or more levels and 1 pupil 7 VA levels.
- 100% met national expectation / 91% exceeded National Expectation.
- 11 of appropriate pupils met CASPA expectations, 82% were above.

- Specialist teacher input over in all primary satellite curriculum classes to boost functional maths skills.
- Increased use of Lego Therapy across the department, developing the use of positional language, knowledge of shape, number and colour.

- 91% of pupils achieved at least 2 VA (sub) levels, 73% 3 or more (sub) levels

- 100% made outstanding progress against the St. Nicholas criteria
- 82% at least met the nationally expected 2 levels of progress; 73% achieved 3 or more levels
- 91% of pupils at least met the National Expectations of 2 levels; 82% exceeded the National Expectations

- Use of Earwig to capture and document evidence or progress.

- Of the 11 pupils with a full CASPA record, 100% at least reached expectation, 91% exceeded this expectation.

Resulting Action 2019/20

- To work collaboratively with staff in the primary department to create the plans and timetables for the PE carousel, in order to improve the range of activities, efficiently delegate staffing to lead activities and ensure consistency in delivery of activities, for all classes.
- To review the training needs within the department to ensure there are enough staff trained in activities such as rebound, trampolining, swimming teaching and climbing wall activities.
- To access a range of physical activities in partnership schools as well as competitions in the community.
- To trial 'community based PE', encouraging classes to access more activities within the community, such as local walks, exploring local parks and possibly visiting softplay centres
- To increase the amount of horse riding opportunities for pupils across the primary department
