

Public Notice: Proact-Scipr-UK® Training

Current Accredited PROACT-SCIPr-UK® Centre (Stone Bay School)

The current Accredited PROACT-SCIPr-UK® Centre licence held by Stone Bay School, on behalf of Kent County Council will cease on 4th July 2018. From that date, **ALL training and use of the programme by MAINSTREAM SCHOOLS & EDUCATIONAL ORGANISATIONS in Kent** will be considered historic (with the only exceptions being the KSENT Special Schools, Abbey Court School, the East Kent Colleges Group, Accredited PROACT-SCIPr-UK® Centres and Accredited PROACT-SCIPr-UK® Sub Centres, Accredited PROACT-SCIPr-UK® Licenced Instructors, or those receiving PROACT-SCIPr-UK directly from Loddon Training and Consultancy). The training registration, ability to use the content, trademark and language of the programme and / or advice given concerning the safe use of Physical Interventions for all affected centres will have expired and ALL staff will have a training status of OUT OF COMPLIANCE. From that date Loddon Training and Consultancy and the Kent Network accept no liability or responsibility for the practice or policies of those schools / centres.

NB: the certification status of the KSENT schools, Abbey Court School and EKC Group will remain unaffected.

Future Accredited PROACT-SCIPr-UK® Centre (St Nicholas School)

As of the 5th July 2018, a new Accredited PROACT-SCIPr-UK® Centre – licence to be held by St. Nicholas School to support the Kent Special Educational Needs Trust (KSENT) will come into place. Should any primary school, SEND educational provision or other centre for children, young people or adults with SEND wish to join the new network / programme and receive training in PROACT-SCIPr-UK® within Kent will need to apply following a full audit of person-specific needs via their local STLS Office, the appropriate LIFT process or, for independent schools / centres, via Stephen King stephen.k@st-nicholas.kent.sch.uk (Kent PROACT-SCIPr-UK® Centre Co-ordinator) from 5/7/18. All applications for training / join the network will need to be made following the Kent SEN Support Service structures in the first instance.

NB: There will be a PROACT-SCIPr-UK® Central Register held by St Nicholas School (maintained on behalf of Loddon Training and Consultancy) to record all dates, delegate contact details and Physical Interventions covered during training in Kent County Council locality. This will incur a small admin fee, to be made payable to St. Nicholas School, Canterbury (as the licence holder).
