This spelling is sometimes used when the /c/ sound is at the start or in the middle of a word, although there is no consistent rule.

This spelling is usually used when the /sh/ sound is at the start of a word. It can also be found in the middle of a word.

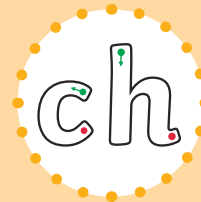

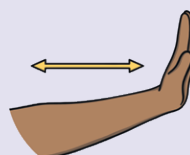
Kit reminds us when and where to use a capital letter.

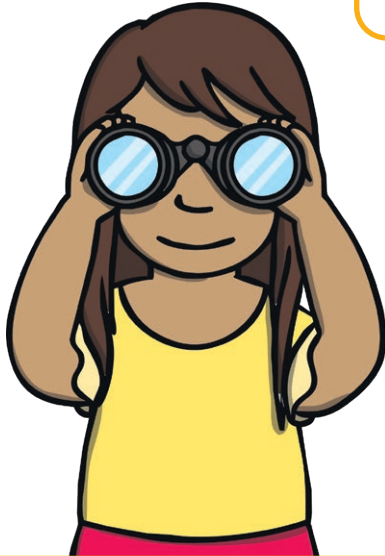
