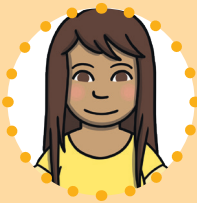
The **ir** grapheme can be used when the /ur/ sound is in the middle or at the end of a word.

bird stir

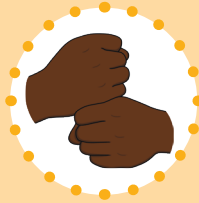


ir is part of the /ur/ sound family:

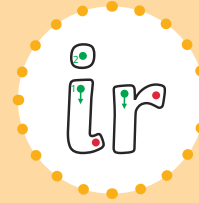

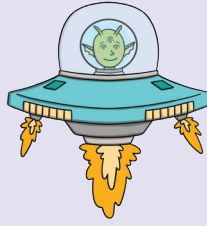
This week, we have been revisiting what we already know about capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.



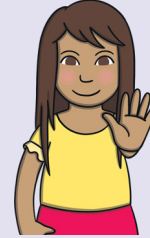
We know that we need:



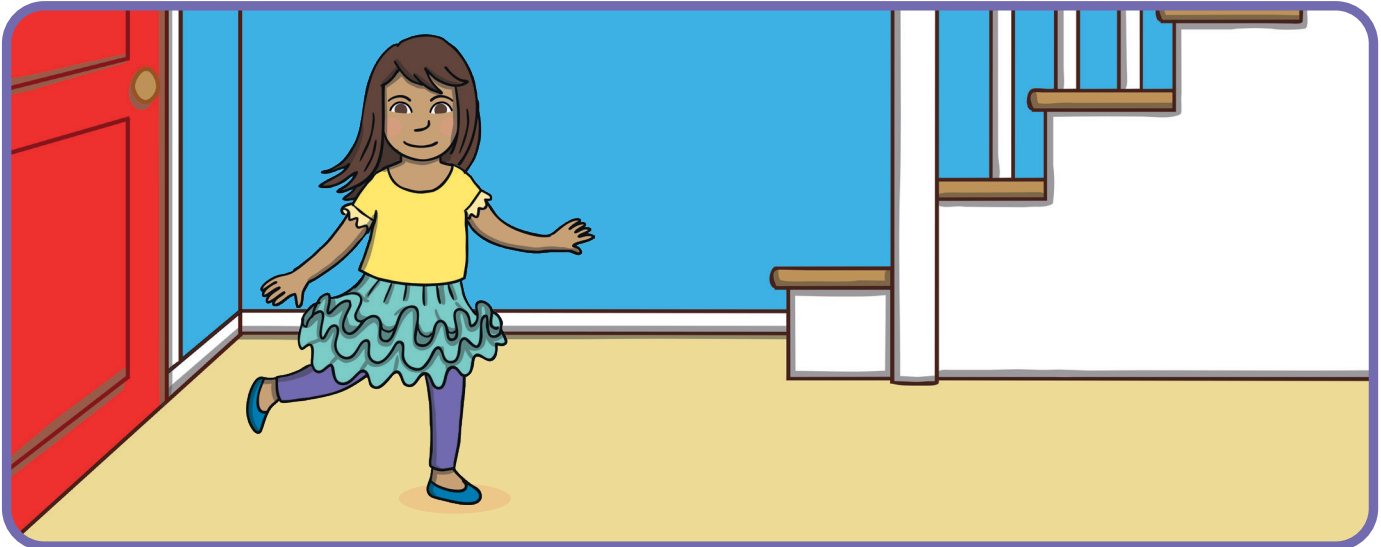
A capital letter at the beginning of a sentence.
