Adding **-ed** to words ending in **e**

When we change words ending in **e** to the past tense, we take away the **e** and add **-ed**.

score
scored
joke
joked

When you add **-ed** to a word that ends in **e**, the **-ed** suffix makes the /d/ or /t/ sound.

Adding **-er** to words ending in **e**

When adding **-er** to words ending in **e**, we take away the **e** and add **-er**.

hike
hiker
bake
baker

We have been learning to spell the common exception words **whole** and **listen**.

This week, we have used the **-ed** suffix to change the tense of verbs.



- **Verbs** are words to describe an action.
- When we add the suffix **-ed** to verbs, it changes them to past tense.
- Past tense is when we talk about something which has already happened.

Happening now:

Sam and Kit **hike** up the hill.

Happened in the past:

Sam and Kit **hiked** up the hill.
