The /ee/ Sound Family

ey

ey is sometimes used when the /ee/ sound is at the end of a word.

y saying /ee/ is used more often than **ey**.

monkey

ea

ea is sometimes used when the /ee/ sound is in the middle of a word.

steam
beach

ie

Sometimes, when **ie** appears in the middle of a word, it makes an /ee/ sound.

chief

At the end of some short words **e** makes an /ee/ sound.

ee

ee is often used in the middle or at the end of words.

see
peeler



e_e

The split digraph **e_e** is often used when the /ee/ sound is in the middle of the word. It can be used at the start of some words.

**y**

When **y** appears at the end of a word, it usually makes an /ee/ sound.

y is used more often than **ey** at the end of words.
