When adding **-er**, **-est** and **-y** to CVC words with a short vowel sound, double the last consonant.

big
hot
sun

bigger
hottest
sunny

CVCC Words

When adding **-er**, **-est** and **-y** to CVCC words, just add it on at the end.

dust
cold
wind

duster
coldest
windy
