

This week, we have been learning to read and spell words containing the suffixes **-ment** and **-ness**.

### **-ment**

Adding the suffix **-ment** turns a verb into a noun.

**enjoyment**  
**payment**

**-ment** can usually be added straight to the root word.

### **-ness**

Adding the suffix **-ness** to an adjective turns it into a noun.

**softness**  
**thickness**

If the root word ends in **y**, you need to replace the **y** with an **i** and then add the suffix.

**happy**      **happiness**  
**tidy**        **tidiness**

We have been learning to spell the common exception words **hour** and **move**.

**enjoyment**      **payment**      **excitement**  
**movement**      **fairness**      **kindness**      **tidiness**      **happiness**

**The athletes ran towards the finish line.**

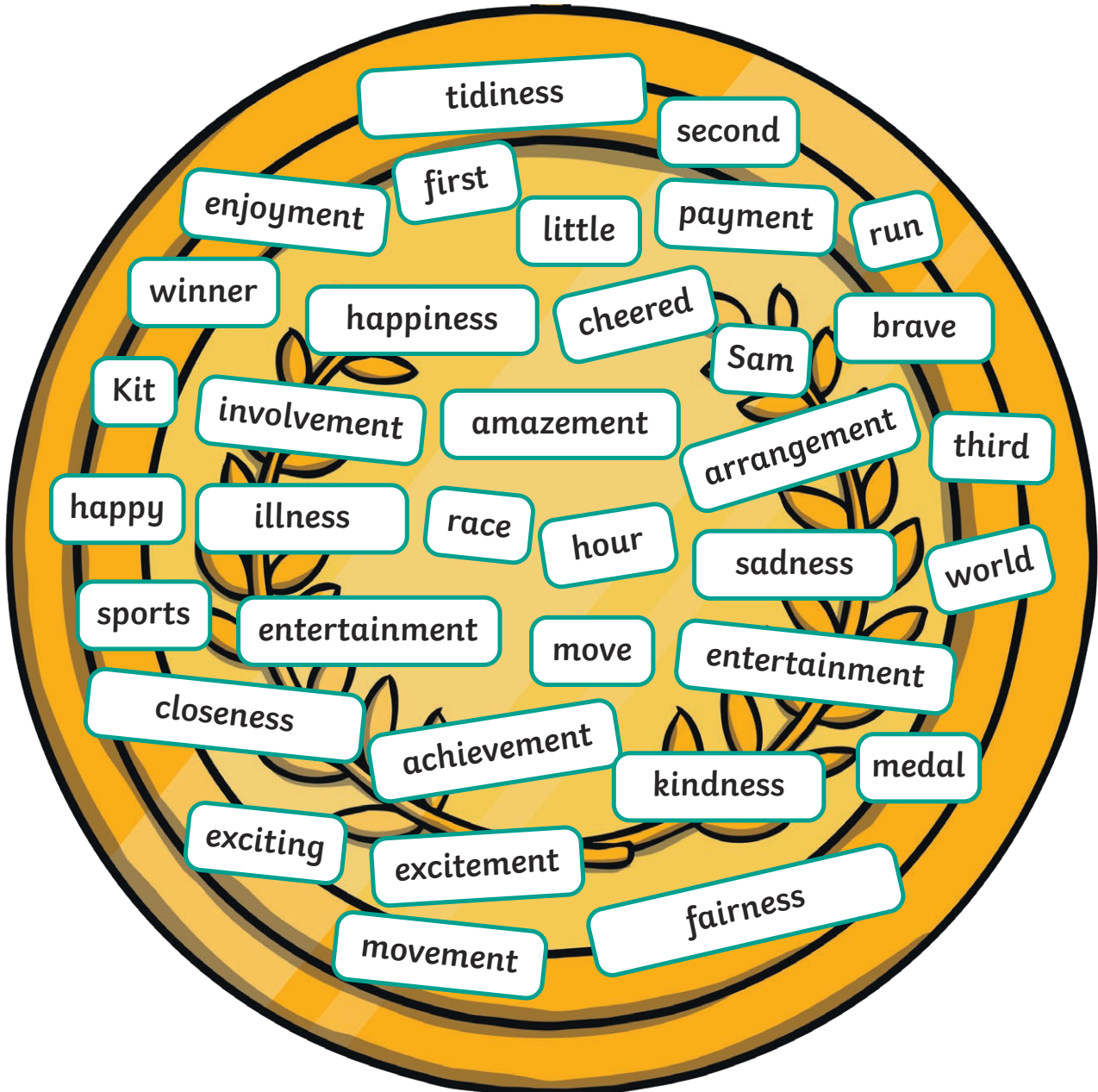
**The strong athletes sprinted rapidly towards the finish line.**
